6 Hour Day (Off Campus for 1st or 7th Period) Students must have no less than a 2.3 cumulative GPA, at least 13 credits (Jr.) or 19 credits (Sr.), and **MUST** have daily transportation to campus (for 1st hour off) or from campus (after 6th hour). The parent/guardian must make sure that the student has transportation on/off campus EVERY DAY! Choosing this option does not guarantee a parking permit. Students who fail to meet eligibility requirements will be scheduled into an alternate class on campus.

Flex Scheduling – This allows Juniors or Seniors to leave campus for Dual Enrollment classes not in Okeechobee and OJT. Students must have at least a 2.5 GPA *and* must have met or are on track to meet online requirements and *all other* graduation requirements including passing required FSA and EOC tests. To be able to leave campus, students must have a permission form (signed by parent) on file in the main office designating off campus periods.

All students must carry at least 6 classes each semester. This includes dual enrollment courses, executive internship, and OJT (on the job training courses for CTE or DCT program).

HONORS/AP Requirements

All students taking advanced level courses are expected to complete summer reading requirements prior to the start of school. *Students are responsible for contacting the Honors/AP teachers to get information about summer reading and/or project prior to the end of the school year.*

OTHER IMPORTANT SCHEDULING INFORMATION

- **Teacher Recommendations and/or Special Applications for courses:** Some courses require Teacher Recommendations and/or Applications. Students are responsible for getting teacher's signatures (on the line provided by course number) and/or for completing and turning in all applications prior to turning in the Course Selection Sheet
- **Alternate electives:** Due to the number of requests for some courses and due to scheduling conflicts, some elective courses chosen may not be available. If alternates are not chosen by the student, then they will be selected by the counselor/admin if necessary.

- **Reading/Math Classes Support Classes:** Students

who have not yet met graduation requirements for Reading and/or Math assessments may be placed in support classes in place of an elective class.

- **OHS Schedule Change Policy:** Students have nine (9) days at the beginning of a semester to request a schedule change. Requests must be made on the Schedule Change Request form and must be signed by student & parent. No change requests will be taken via email or phone. **Changes are NOT guaranteed!**
- **Dual Enrollment Course Requirements:** For IRSC dual enrollment course selection, students must meet the GPA and test requirements. **All IRSC Dual Enrollment procedures *MUST* be completed (including test scores, dual enrollment application (for first time DE students) & online course registration through IRSC) is due by the last day of school, 5/27/21!**
- **All course requests must be entered into Skyward and completed Course Selection Sheets (with ALL required signatures!) must be turned into students' Guidance Counselors by 5/21/21. After this date Skyward will be locked and no changes will be able to be made in Skyward at that point.** If changes need to be made then students must turn in a completed Course Change Request form which is available in the Guidance Office or on the school website in the Guidance Section.
